

ADR INSTITUTE OF ONTARIO (ADRIO) PILOT MEDIATION INTERNSHIP PROGRAM AGREEMENT

Between

("the Intern")

(and)

("the Supervisor")

WHEREAS the ADR Institute of Ontario ("ADRIO") has developed a Pilot Mediation Internship Program ("the Program")

AND WHEREAS the parties hereto wish to enter into the Pilot ADRIO Mediation Internship Program Agreement ("the Agreement") to undertake such Program

THE PARTIES agree as follows:

1. Definitions

"Parties" refers to the Supervisor and the Intern

2. The parties agree that neither ADRIO nor ADR Institute of Canada (ADRIC) are parties to this agreement
3. The Supervisor will provide and the Intern will participate in the program in the terms set out in the Pilot Mediation Internship Program attached hereto as Exhibit "A"
4. In particular, the Supervisor undertakes to provide the Program to and with the Intern in the terms set out therein
5. The Intern undertakes to accept the Program as therein set out, to set aside the time prescribed therein and to make herself/himself available as required
6. The Intern acknowledges that his or her completion of the Pilot Mediation Internship Program is not assurance that his or her application for accreditation or certification by any organization will be approved
7. The Intern waives any claim he or she might have against the Supervisor, ADRIO or ADRIC
8. The Intern will pay to the Supervisor the sum of \$2,500 plus HST as arranged between them, for the cost of the Program
9. The Supervisor will evaluate the Intern on the prescribed form at least twice during the internship, assigning PASS, FAIL, EXCEL evaluations, based on items 1 to 12 of the Skills and Processes to be Covered set out in the Mediation Internship Program attached hereto as Exhibit "A"

10. This Agreement may be terminated by either party on 15 days notice, or the Intern assigned to another qualified Supervisor with her/his consent, and the Intern will be refunded the proportional amount of her/his internship fee paid to the Supervisor
11. If an Intern disputes an evaluation by her/his Supervisor, an appeal lies to ADRIO, who shall appoint a 3-person panel of qualified members who are not members of the Internship Committee to decide the appeal.
12. If a dispute arises between the parties on any other issue under this agreement, they will first attempt to settle the dispute with the assistance of a member appointed by ADRIO, who is not a member of the Internship Committee, and if not settled, to a single member who is not a member of the Internship Committee, whose decision will be final and binding on the parties
