# EXPLORING THE WORLD OF RESTORATIVE PROCESS

*3-Day Program. Advanced. Intensive. Interactive.*

*This workshop is ideal for anyone who is working within the realm of conflict management and is interested in learning more about how restorative processes can fit in their work.*

Restorative practices are becoming increasingly and notably common in ADR, with applications in workplaces, and schools, as well as many other diverse social and criminal justice settings. This advanced program thoughtfully combines 3 days of intensive and interactive knowledge-sharing and group exercises. The main facilitator and other guest speakers will take participants on an exploration of the world of restorative practices in ADR. Attendees will hear from those in the field as we examine psychological and social elements and review a rich variety of formats and applications. This program will help determine if, where and - perhaps most importantly - *how* restorative practices fit into your plans.

***This workshop employs a blend of knowledge-sharing from the main facilitator, interactive group exercises and text analyses as well as interviews and facilitated discussions with other subject matter experts.***

## The following topics will be covered:

Psycho/physiology of restorative processes (e.g., brain development; criminal/harm-causing behaviours; fear, trauma and healing)

Cultural and institutional norms; decolonization; diversity and intersectionality; power imbalance and rebalance (power assessment); the role of shame as social control

Forms of Restorative processes – how they are the same, how they are different and nuanced?
